Our Story

The Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest is a Florida 501-c3 non-profit Community Development and Charitable organization, founded and run by Motorcycle enthusiasts.

Our Mission

Support charities making a local impact and promote economic development through motorcycle culture and motorcycle related events.

In 2018, the monthly "Brooksville Bike Rally" was started a as a funding source and component of the Hernando County Growers Association, Inc. The weekly farmers market provided food insecurity solutions to the residents of Hernando, Citrus, Pasco, and Sumter counties and supporting local agriculture.

By 2020, the Rally had grown so significantly, and the farmers market developed into a true cooperative that the Hernando County Growers Association entered into a lease agreement with Hernando County Parks and Recreation and moved into the Little Rock Cannery.

In 2022, the monthly *Brooksville, Bike Rally* became the 3-day annual *Hernando County Bike Fest* and generated tens of thousands of dollars for charities including \$6,700 towards the construction of a Gary Sinise Foundation home for a disabled veteran.

In 2023, the Hernando County Bike Fest was renamed to the *Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest*.

In 2024, the expanded *Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest* partnered with the City of Inverness and moved to its permanent home at Whispering Pines Park. It was attended by well over 15,000 people, and nearly 8,000 motorcycles.

The 2025 Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest is joined by the Citrus County Tourist Development Council and promises to be the best yet. Be a part of your community's growth and support local charities by partnering with us. The Bike Fest will be returning to Whispering Pines Park, 1700 Forest Dr, Inverness, FL 34453 Friday through Sunday, March 14-16, 2025 for our fourth annual motorcycle and music event. The Nature Coast spans eight counties including Wakulla, Jefferson, Taylor, Dixie, Levy, Citrus, Hernando, and Pasco putting The Nature Coast Bike Fest right in the middle, and offering an affordable Daytona style event without all the stress of city congestion and urban sprawl.

A minimum of 30,000 copies (minimum 16 page) will be distributed from January through March, featuring sponsor recognition, event schedule, vendor map, area guide, featured articles about the FLNCBF, sponsors, partners. The publication will feature stories contributed by recognized local authors about the Nature Coast and area attractions, as well as a community events calendar spanning January through April.





Event Posters. Event posters are placed in a wide variety of businesses, restaurants and other locations.

Radio. The Bike Fest is advertised with sponsor recognition on Hits 106, 96.7 The Fox Classic Rock, Z103 Nature Coast Country, and Citrus 95.3. Digital Calendars and Websites. The Bike Fest is featured on hundreds of local, regional and national motorcycle, community and festival event calendars.



Venues

Whispering Pines Park boasts 290-acres of natural beauty and wildlife just one minute and under a mile from Historic Downtown Inverness. Well wooded it features hiking trails, a wide variety of athletic facilities, a community pool, children's playground, multiple pavilions and ample parking surrounding the event area.

Safe and secure with plenty of light and direct access to a controlled intersection on State Road 44, the park is easy to reach from any direction.










The 2025 Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest Whispering Pine Event Map


